## WELCOME

Welcome to the event pack for the Warhammer 40,000: Stockport Dreadnought! Here you will be able to find the information you require to take part in the next Warhammer 40,000 Dreadnought.

## WHAT IS A DREADNOUGHT EVENT?

The Dreadnought line of events follow a scaling point system for any game format, whether that be 40k, Age of Sigmar or The Hobbit. Starting off with a smaller points value scaling up over the course of a weekend letting you experience the skirmish sized games right up to some grand battles!

## GATHERING YOUR FORCES

To play at a Dreadnought event and enjoy your experience fully, you will need a number of things. Below is a handy checklist and visual aid for making sure you remember everything you need for the day.

- Your army, of course!
- Your ticket - can't get in without it...
- Accommodation for the over night stay.
- Dice, so you can roll all them 6s.
- Tape measures, essential!
- Rulebook, to play by. We all forget things!
- Appropriate literature (Codex, source book, supplements etc.)
- Emergency hobby tool kit just in case.
- Your army lists (see below).

## YOUR ARMY LIST

When you attend any Dreadnought event you will need to bring two copies of your army list and submit a digital copy to the following email address before the event: [armylist@dreadnoughtevents.co.uk](mailto:armylist@dreadnoughtevents.co.uk)

Without submitting your list you will not be able to take part in the tournament.

## SELECTING YOUR ARMY

In order to play in this Dreadnought event you will need to bring a total of 2,500 points, separated into 5 battle-forged lists as follows:

- 500 This is your base force.
- 1000 MUST include the previous 500 point list
- 1500 MUST include the previous 1000 point list
- 2000 MUST include the previous 1500 point list
- 2500 MUST include the previous 2000 point list

This tournament is designed to provide you with a variety of gaming experience over the weekend to give you the most amount of fun!

**PLEASE NOTE:** The only other restriction in building your list is that in the first 500 points you may NOT take a Lord of war.

## THE EMPEROR'S CODE

Attending any Dreadnought event we expect and require you to follow the Emperor's Code which is laid out below to ensure everyone has the most possible fun at the event. We expect that:

- All your models have been produced by Games Workshop (Citadel, Forge World or Games Workshop).
- All your models must be fully painted, based and assembled.
- Your army lists must be selected from current Games Workshop publications.
- You don't use any proxied models or ones produced outside of Games Workshop unless a Dreadnought staff member approves it.
- You seek approval for any major conversion from a Dreadnought Events staff member.
- You are fair, kind and even to all your opponents.
- You embrace the Most Important Rule; play in the spirit of the game and do not get bogged down in the details of the rules.

If you and your army fail to comply with the Emperor's Code in any capacity you will either be penalised with a points deduction from the tournament standings or, in certain circumstances, you will be asked to leave the venue for the remainder of the event. We have a 0 tolerance policy on violence and abuse at the event, you have been warned, remember we are here to have fun and throw some dice!

## GAMES

Throughout the event, your opponents will be selected for you and games lengths will be variable depending on the point value being played.

The amount of scenery on the tables is predetermined by the event organisers but if you AND your opponent wish to move it around you may do so.

The tournament is a 5 round Match-Play event where a mission is randomly selected at the start of each game by the tournament organisers, these will either be maelstrom missions or eternal war.

## RULES AT THE TOURNAMENT

The event will be using the latest published rules, this includes publications such as Chapter approved missions as a potential selected scenario and the new Smite rules listed in Chapter Approved will be in play.

## SCORING

What better way to gauge who is best than to score everything? Scoring over the Dreadnought event is mostly made up of wins, draws and losses you gain by playing the games over the weekend, however, your equipment and sportsmanship are also taken into account and can award you those crucial extra points!

- 5 points for a win
- 3 points for a draw
- 1 point for a loss
- 1 point for EACH victory point achieved in the game
- 5 points for every Favourite Game Vote
  
- 15 collective points for having a dull equipment list and following the Emperor's Code.

The winner will be the player with the highest points at the end of the weekend. In the event of a tie the following deciders will take place:

- Most favourite game votes
- Most victory point over the tournament
- Most games won
- Total Victory point difference

## ROUND 1 DRAW

The round 1 draw for this event will be live-streamed on our Facebook page near the time of the event so keep your eyes peeled. The links will be posted in multiple places to make sure you get access to it.

## THE AWARD CEREMONY

At the end of the event there will be an Award Ceremony where we will acknowledge the achievements you have earned over the weekend. The following awards will be presented at the ceremony:

**THE DREADNOUGHT** - A strategic leader and force to be reckoned with. Awarded to the play who achieved the highest score throughout the tournament weekend.

**THE SEAL OF PURITY** - A true show of colours. Awarded to the player with the most favourite game votes.

**THE EMPEROR'S BLESSING** - It's a true skill to adorn your warriors with armour fit for their skill. Awarded to the player who has the best-painted army.

**THE CODEX** - Many can write a story, but few can forge a legend. Awarded to the player who presents the best-themed army across the event.

**THE RUSTY WRENCH** - A valiant effort without results is still an effort. Awarded to the lowest scoring player of the tournament.
